**Interparking has entered into a number of partnerships, not only with players in the mobility and transport sector, but also with service providers who expand the range of products and services we can offer our customers.**

**MULTIMODAL TRANSPORT:  
THE FUTURE OF URBAN MOBILITY**

Interparking provides parking spaces close to major public transport hubs: metro stations, bus lines, train stations or close to connections to airports and ferry terminals.

In Germany, our subsidiary Contipark, through a joint venture with the Deutsche Bahn railway company, provides parking services close to train stations, particularly thanks to a mobile app which enables people to reserve a train ticket and reserve a parking space in the same transaction.

In Belgium, users of STIB, the Brussels public transport network, can load their ticket directly onto their Pcard.

**FRANCE: A MULTIMODAL HUB AT  
VERSAILLES**

As part of a public service delegation (PSD), the City of Versailles has tasked Interparking France with managing and operating the Cathedral car park and the future Chantiers car park since 1 January 2019.

Versailles-Chantiers train station welcomes 25 million passengers each year. The new car park there provides 373 spaces over two un-

derground levels. It is part of the redevelopment of the quarter around the train station, which includes the creation of a multimodal hub and a new bus station. As for the other car park, located at the foot of Saint-Louis Cathedral, it provides 317 spaces over six underground levels. The purpose of redeveloping the Chantiers quarter is to facilitate access to the Saint-Louis quarter for all users, including people who travel by bus, by bicycle or on foot.

### NETHERLANDS: BY BICYCLE OR WITH A DRIVER

The Pcard+ provides access to optimal mobility. In Amsterdam for example, Pcard holders get a 50% discount on bicycle hire from our partner Amsterdam Bike Rent. The same goes for customers who opt for the "Rent a Bob" service, which avoids drivers getting back behind the wheel when they are tired or after having had one too many.

### PARTNER OF HOSPITALS

In Europe, Interparking manages many car parks directly linked to hospitals. To facilitate and smooth access for hospital staff, patients and visitors alike, we have put in place a number

of effective solutions. In Spain, for example, Interparking offers a special rate for patients with chronic diseases. To mention another example, Interparking makes it easier for hospital staff in the Netherlands to find a parking space using the Bluefield app.

In Rome, Interparking acquired the 14 car parks (2,884 spaces) serving Gemelli Hospital (1,558 beds), Italy's largest hospital. In 2018, Interparking acquired 100% of the shares in Bergamo Hospital Parking, which manages all 2,914 parking spaces for this huge hospital. Papa Giovanni XXIII Hospital in Bergamo is home to one of Italy's most renowned oncology centers. In the Netherlands, Interparking also manages 17 hospital car parks.
